Lifeguard

This course will train individuals to have a working knowledge of an aquatic environment, prevention of hazards in an aquatic area and potential lifesaving skills. Includes certification in CPR, First Aid and AED.

Course Prerequisites:

- Must be a minimum of 16 years old
- Must be able to pass Physical Competency requirements (swim 300 yards and swim to bottom of deep end)

American Red Cross CPR, First Aid and AED

CPR/AED

Students are taught how to perform CPR for infants, children and adults; how and when to use an Automated External Defibrillator (AED); use of a barrier device during CPR; how to work with another rescuer and how to relieve a foreign body airway obstruction.

First Aid

Designed to provide the skills necessary to effectively assess and maintain life during moments immediately following an emergency. This class covers sudden illnesses, wounds, burns and heat and cold related emergencies.



Online Learning

Online learning combines the convenience of online learning with a shortened practical skills session in order to meet both knowledge and skill objectives for learners. This option is available at any time and can be done at home.

OR

Classroom Learning

Classroom learning is taught in a group scenario and is offered periodically throughout the year. All learning and skills are taught in one session. Call for class availability.

There must be at least 4 people in a class for it to be taught. Participants must be registered prior to class.
