INFORMATION:

ONLINE REGISTRATION!

TEAM INFORMATION:

- A maximum number of 6 players may be on each team's roster.
- Men (up-and-coming High School Sophomores through adults) are eligible.
- If a player is replaced on your roster before the rosters are "frozen" he may **NOT** return for play.
- Divisions: A, B, & C (may be combined due to participation levels).

REGISTRATION

- New this season will be **Online Registration**. You may register online or stop by the YMCA to register.
- Begins: May 1, 2017
- Concludes: May 27th (online) and May 29th (at the YMCA)
- Individual Participant Fee: \$35 (YMCA Members) and \$64 (non-members).
- Individual (per-player) fees must be paid at the time of registration.
- There will be a \$10.00 late registration fee for any registrations after the Registration Deadline should space allow.
- While registration this season is on an individual basis, you will be able to designate your team or team captain during the online registration process.

MISC.

- Games will begin in mid-June and will end by mid-August.
- There will be a Post-Season tournament held at the conclusion of the regular season.
- All games will be played at the YMCA and may be played on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday evenings. The first game will begin at 6:15 while the 2nd game through 4th games will begin at 7:00, 8:00, and 9:00 p.m.

RULES:

A copy of the League Rules will be sent to each participant. Remember, the YMCA is a Christian organization and we all must respect its mission and principles. The 3 on 3 Basketball League is a part of our house here at the Greene County YMCA. In our house we expect people to behave, so here is our house rule: **Good Clean Competition we like; fighting, trash talking, taunting, cursing, and poor character we don't like.** Break our rules and we will ban you, **NO EXCEPTIONS, NO SECOND CHANCES! A Sportsmanship Rating System will be in effect and is defined in the rules.** Technical fouls will be issued and / or Sportsmanship Points will be deducted for cursing, arguing, and other forms of disrespect and / or inappropriate behavior before, during, or after a game. Sportsmanship is stressed and must be displayed at all times. Any player receiving a technical foul will be immediately ejected from the game plus will serve a one game suspension. A player receiving his second technical foul (during the season) will be immediately ejected and suspended for 3 games. A player receiving his third technical foul (during the season) will be ejected from the game and will be suspended for the remainder of the season with no refund given. Any player involved in a fight will be immediately ejected and suspended from the league. Fans and spectators are also subject to these rules and penalties. All appeals will be heard by the Program's Director (Danny Silvers). Final decisions will be made by the Program Director and he reserves the right to decrease, uphold, or lengthen any and all penalties.
